

# You must use ArriveCAN to enter Canada!

All travellers coming to Canada **must** submit their mandatory information in **ArriveCAN** (free App or website), including their digital proof of vaccination and a quarantine plan within 72 hours before arriving in Canada. For more information, visit [www.canada.ca/arrivecan](http://www.canada.ca/arrivecan).

- If you're using the ArriveCAN App, make sure you have the most up-to-date version in the Google Play Store and the App Store for iPhone.
- Travellers without a smartphone or without mobile data can submit their information by signing in online at [www.canada.ca/arrivecan](http://www.canada.ca/arrivecan).

If you are a foreign national travelling for discretionary purposes and don't submit your information through ArriveCAN, you may be denied entry into Canada.

Canadian citizens, permanent residents or persons registered under the *Indian Act* won't be denied entry, but you:

- won't be eligible for the fully vaccinated traveller exemption (i.e. you may have to quarantine)
- may face additional delays at the border for public health questioning
- may be subject to fines or enforcement action
